*Special KHBIF Note: Unless the KHBIF Affiliate rules change, show participants are required to participate in 3 RMHA sanctioned shows, one of which must be an "A" show. Also, please note, the RMHA International will NOT count toward High Point Awards this year, but it will count toward KHBIF.

The Trail competition segment of the KHBIF award program will continue the same as in the past - horses may compete in as many competitions as desired but MUST compete in at least 3 to be qualified for KHBIF Trail awards. Only 3 competitions' points will count. They may be at shows or any obstacle competition with any organization - ETS, Southern Expo Trail Challenge, Equine Affaire Trail Challenge, NMHA, KMSHA, etc. Wendy Montgomery can answer questions about competitions or scoring if you all need any clarification.

The RMHA also has a Trail Mileage and Versatile Horse of the Year programs. They are described in detail at rmhorse.com. They are separate from KHBIF.
