- If you have any questions, give one of us a call. We'll try to help in any way we can.
- Please see Lyngle early Tuesday afternoon with payment for your classes so she can pick up your packet at the show office.
- Please, let us know what classes you are interested in as soon as you know. Show management has asked that make entries 5 classes ahead.

More International Info.

- The cut-off for entering or scratching is 5 classes ahead also.
- Grand Championship entries need to be made by noon Saturday
- Championship entries cannot be made in advance. Completing a preliminary class qualifies you for a championship. Placing in the top 5 qualifies you for the open Grand Championship classes. Julie Tucker can give advice or see the description of qualifying classes available

on the web site

- Charlie and Mary Kelley will be working out who will be riding which horses when a change is necessary.
- Gaitkeeper.com is being used to make entries this year. Ads and scratches will need to be made at the show office, however. We had hoped those could be made on-line but we won't be able to do that this year.
- Paybacks will go to the trainers, if requested at check-in so that will be simpler than we thought it would be. Check-out will also be required.

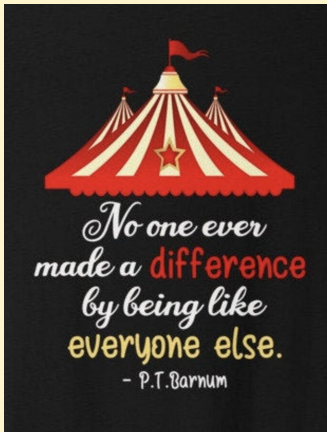

Hot Off the Press ~ More Important Information



As the we get ready for the RMHA International, there are a few more bits of information that I thought might be helpful. Be sure to go to the RMHA Facebook page for updates. There is a lot of information that is being added there. At

rmhorse.com, scroll down to the “Championships” to see updates. There are minor changes to the show bill. he classes are exactly the same but there are some events that have been added. There is a fees and rental sheet that includes golf cart rental information. Lyngle will order bedding in advance so it should be waiting on the crew when we arrive about noon on Tuesday. There is a link to “Classes by Division” that will be helpful if you are searching for specific classes. For example, all the amateur classes are listed together by division. The host hotels are listed there as well. I believe everyone showing with us

already has their accommodations though. Most of the “Fact Sheet” has already been utilized. You will see a W9 form that is required. The trainer will have to submit that because of the paybacks (unless you are bringing a horse Charlie nor Mary Kelley trains). The adult and youth Special Awards are now on the website. The forms can be printed at home or picked up in the show office. Lyngle will help with those. There is also a ”Championship Qualifying Class List”. It tells you which preliminary classes qualify for the Grand Championships. Please refer to this list and help us make sure all horses are entered in their Grand Championship classes by the deadline.
